Employee input is critical to the decision-making process as UCI begins evaluating the feasibility of developing below market value housing options for employees on land owned by the University of California in north Irvine. Home ownership and rental opportunities would be available in a new community developed approximately 11 miles from UCI's main campus and 15 miles from UCI Health in Orange.
